

CANACCORD GENUITY GROUP INC. DISCLOSES CANCELLATION OF SHARES AND TOTAL VOTING RIGHTS

TORONTO, January 4, 2016 – Canaccord Genuity Group Inc. (the "Company") (TSX: CF, LSE: CF.) announces the cancellation effective as of December 31, 2015, of 54,700 of its common shares purchased pursuant to the normal course issuer bid (NCIB)/buy-back programme announced on August 10, 2015. The Company has purchased 482,367 common shares under the NCIB/buy-back programme which authorizes it to purchase up to 5,163,736 of its common shares between August 13, 2015 and August 12, 2016. All of these shares have now been cancelled.

For the purposes of the Financial Conduct Authority's Disclosure and Transparency Rules, the Company announces that, as at December 31, 2015, the total number of common shares in issue was 103,107,990. The Company holds in its treasury 717,873 common shares acquired by wholly-owned subsidiaries from employees or former employees in accordance with pre-existing contractual arrangements. The Company is not entitled to vote the shares held in treasury but the common shares otherwise each carry the right to one vote. The figure 102,390,117 (the difference of the total number of common shares in issue less the number of shares held in treasury) may therefore be used by shareholders in the Company as the denominator for the calculations by which they will determine if they are required to notify their interest in, or a change in their interest in, the share capital of the Company under the FCA's Disclosure and Transparency Rules.
